



PROGRAMS & SERVICES





The WCA assists anyone who is experiencing or has experienced domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking. We offer an inclusive, safe, and welcoming space where survivors can receive various services in one location, ranging from crisis intervention to long-term supportive care. Services are provided at no cost.

ADVOCACY

Skilled guidance in the aftermath of a crisis to aid in safety planning, assessing immediate needs, identifying resources, and navigating the various systems survivors may encounter.

SELF-SUFFICIENCY

Specialized case management to assist with planning, monitoring, and achieving goals leading to independence, empowerment, and safety.

HOUSING

Support locating emergency housing for immediate safety and relocation to permanent, stable housing.

LEGAL

Professional advice and assistance with legal matters related to a survivor's experience of abuse.

CLINICAL

Crisis counseling, direct therapeutic assistance, and support in processing emotions and experiences in the aftermath of a crisis.

PEER SUPPORT

Facilitated group dialogue for exploring experiences, receiving support, and working through the stigma of victimization among peers.
